CHEESE SAVOURIES

This is one of several simple but tasty recipes handed down to my mother Margaret, from her mother Dorothy Mirfin. Gran, as she was known to us, lived in a lovely old stone house in St. Peters in Adelaide and mum and her sister Nancy were brought up here.

When we went back to Australia in July 2004, I took Katie and Michael to see the house, as I had very fond memories of it from my childhood. Of course all the grape vines that I remembered so well down the side of the house had gone, and so too had the old Norfolk Pines with their gently cooing doves. There was now a great big garage at the back and an extension to the house. Shortly after we returned to Canada it went on the market for the first time since it was sold after Gran died in the mid 1980's.

It apparently sold for A\$750.000!

1 cup grated tasty cheese
1 small egg
2 rashers bacon finely chopped
mustard, salt and pepper to taste(try onion salt)
4-6 slices toasting bread, generously buttered

Combine cheese, egg and flavourings and spread on slices of buttered bread. Cut into finger lengths. Sprinkle with bacon, put on a baking tray and bake in a hot oven for 7-10 minutes. Serve at once!
